#### Glossary:

LHA = Local health area. LHA population includes population within and outside of municipal boundaries, and those living on reserve lands.

CY = City (CY), DM = District Municipality, VL = Village, TP = Township, IGD = Indian Government District (IGD). This is an area that is a municipality or an area that is deemed to be equivalent to a municipality for statistical reporting purposes.

CA = Census agglomeration. An area consisting of one or more neighbouring municipalities situated around a core. A CA must have a total population of at least 100,000 of which 10,000 or more live in the core.

POPCTR = Population centre. A POPCTR has a population of at least 1,000 and a population density of 400 persons or more per square kilometre, based on the current census population count. All areas outside population centres are classified as rural areas.

DPL = Designated place. Usually a small community that does not meet the criteria used to define municipalities or population centres (areas with a population of at least 1,000 and no fewer than 400 persons per square kilometre).
